### Your system is more than 10 years old

# You're calling for repairs more often

The parts of your HVAC system will wear out over time, and this happens more often as the unit gets older.




#### Short cycling

Short cycling is the term for turning on and off frequently, which could indicate a problem with the pilot light or ignition.



## Loud banging or rattling noises

The furnace or air conditioner should hum quietly in the background. Banging or other loud noises may indicate a loose or broken part.



#### air quality

Stale, musty air can indicate a build-up of dust and debris in the furnace, which is circulating throughout your house and polluting the air.




#### Spotty heating or cooling
